



31179 Northern Hemisphere Constellations (40 Slides)

Description

These slides are actual color photographs of 40 well-known constellations covering the sky from the north celestial pole to -50° S declination. They show stars to between the 6th and 7th magnitudes. Star colors are very obvious even in the faintest stars. Most slides cover 45° of arc on the diagonal. They have all been photographed with the same camera system so that all magnitudes and colors are consistent from slide to slide. The prominent constellation shapes easily stand out in the star field.
